1. The Polycom VSX Codec Family: V500, v700, 3000, 5000, 6000, 7000s, 7000E, 8000, Mobile Responder (VSX-8000), Instructor RP (Vsx-8000). Version 8.5.3 is approved for entry into the Legacy Systems Waiver Program. In accordance with the terms of the reference, this memorandum relieves the Program Manager of all interoperability documentation and testing for the program.
2. The system will continue in the Legacy Program until all versions of the system are phased out of the Department of Defense inventory, not to exceed 5 years. Should the Program Manager determine that the system will continue or conduct spiral development, he/she will notify the Joint Staff. The system will then be removed from the Legacy Program and will follow the JCIDS documentation and interoperability testing process.
